

Textbooks Purchase



- Online purchase for textbooks is recommended and is available until **24 December 2024** from the website: www.pacificbookstores.com (self-collection or homedelivery with charge \$14.90).
 - If you are offered subjects at a more demanding level and have decided to accept the offer, you can start purchasing the relevant textbooks.
 - Items purchased from the school bookshop can be exchanged within 1 week of purchase with the school's booklist and official receipt. Please ensure that there are no markings (e.g. writing of name/class) before exchanging.

Uniform Purchase

- Only walk-in purchase is available.
- Exchange can be made within 30 days with proof of purchase and the uniforms must be in good condition.



Financial Matters: Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS)

<Singapore Citizen students from households with gross monthly household income (GHI) of \$3,000 and below, or per capita income (PCI) of \$750 and below are eligible>

Existing FAS students:

- Eligible students should have already submitted their applications for 2025 at Primary School. Please approach the General Office to collect the FAS letters.
- Purchase textbooks and uniforms <u>only after you have received the FAS</u> <u>approval letter.</u>

New applicants:

- Hardcopy forms are also available at the ADSS General Office on the 1st day of school.
- E-FAS application form is available via <u>Parents Gateway, under Services.</u>



School Smart Card (EZ-link card)

- A) All students entering Secondary One in Jan 2025 will be issued with a new Secondary level School Smart Card (SSC).
- B) While waiting for their new SSC, students can continue to use their Primary level School Smart Cards (SSCs) for concessionary travel.
- C) Students can purchase the Bus Concession Pass (BCP) for Secondary School students using the Primary level SSCs.




